A physician, hospital, clinic or employer <u>must report</u> known or suspected cases of <u>occupational diseases</u> or workplace aggravated <u>health conditions</u> to the Michigan Department of Licensing & Regulatory Affairs. Under Part 56 of P.A. 368 of 1978, the report is to be filed <u>within 10 days after the discovery</u> of the disease or condition on a form furnished by LARA. These forms can be obtained from LARA, Michigan Occupational Safety & Health Administration (517) 284-7740.
