

Case 253. 56-year-old truck driver sustained a fatal crush injury to his chest.

A 56-year-old male truck driver sustained a fatal crush injury to his chest. The decedent had delivered a flatbed trailer load of coiled steel to a warehouse. While the steel coils were being unloaded from the trailer with an overhead crane, the decedent was witnessed to collapse. The sequence of events leading to the injury is unknown.

MIOSHA General Industry Safety and Health Division did not issue any citations to the decedent's employer.
